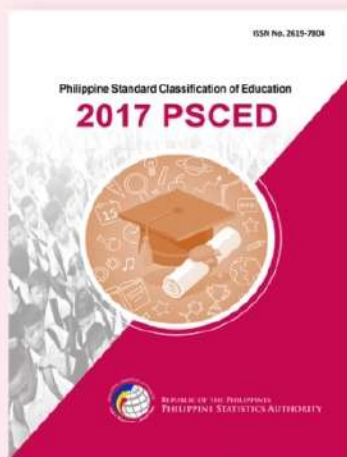
Approving and Adopting the 2016 Philippine Standard Classification of Education
