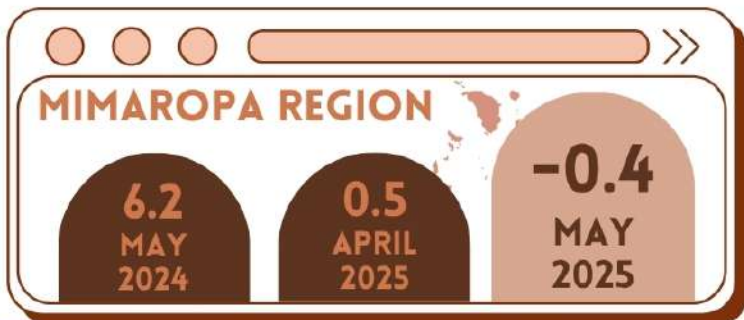
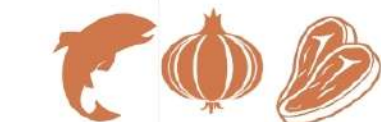


MIMAROPA REGION INFLATION RATE FOR BOTTOM 30% INCOME HOUSEHOLDS (2018=100) MAY 2025
