



### PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF GAINFUL WORKERS BY AGE AND SEX




### PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF GAINFUL WORKERS BY PLACE OF WORK




### PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF GAINFUL WORKERS BY MAJOR SECTOR OF BUSINESS/INDUSTRY
