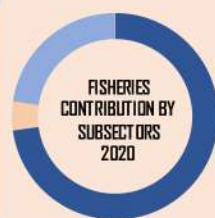

TECHNICAL NOTES:

Fisheries

All activities related to the act or business of fishing, culturing, preserving, processing, marketing, developing, continuing and managing aquatic resources and the fishery areas including the privilege to fish or take aquatic resources thereof (RA 5650).

Commercial

Cover fishing operations in marine waters that make use of boat of more than three (3) gross tons.

Marine Municipal

Cover fishing operations in marine waters that make use of fishing vessels of three (3) gross tons or less, or fishing not regarding the use of fishing vessels.

Aquaculture

Is a fishery operations involving all forms of raising and culturing of fish fishery species in fresh, brackish and marine water areas.

Inland Municipal

Is the catching of fish, crustaceans, molluscs, and other aquatic animals and plants in inland water like lakes, river, dams, marshes, etc. using fishing vessels of three (3) gross tons or less or fishing not requiring the use of fishing vessels.
