Consumer Price Index (CPI) is a measure in the changes in the average price level of goods and services that most people buy for their day-to-day consumption. It measures the composite change in the consumer prices of various commodities over time.

## **Purchasing Power of the Peso**

In January 2024, the PPP was calculated to have a value of P0.76 on the average, which means that P1.00 in 2018 is only worth 76 centavos. Also, on the average, an individual needs P131.30, or P31.30 more, to buy the same basket of goods that was worth P100.00 in 2018.
