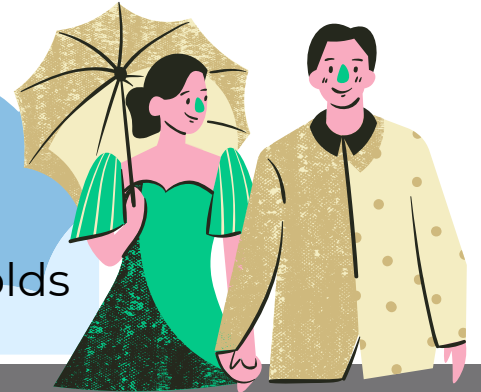

### 2 Calapan City

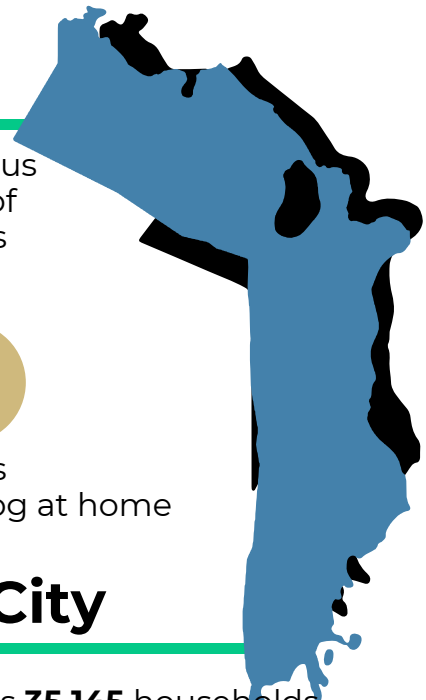
**99.3%**

NOTE: **Language/dialect** generally spoken at home refers to the language or dialect generally used or spoken by the members of the household most of the time at home. It provides a measure of the linguistic homogeneity or difference in the population.
