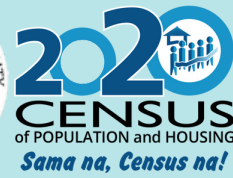


Population Characteristics of Senior Citizens in the Province of Oriental Mindoro

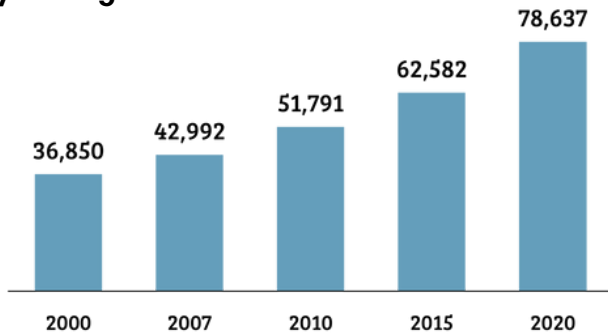


DID YOU KNOW ?

Senior Citizen is defined as any person / resident citizen of the Philippines whose age is 60 years old and over as defined in Section 3 of the Republic Act 9994, otherwise known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010. Globally, older persons refer to those individuals whose age is at least 60 years.

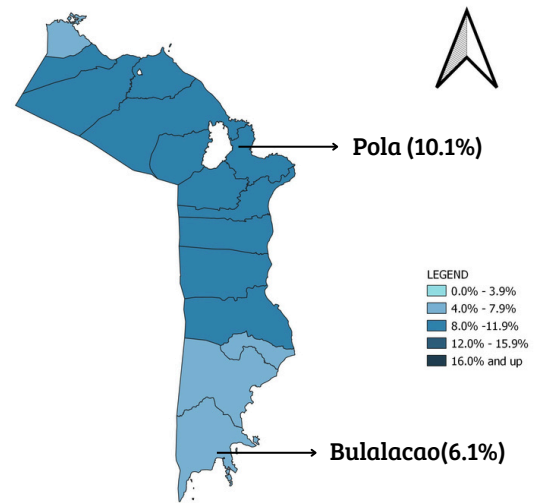


In 2020, the number of persons 60 years old and over in Oriental Mindoro registered a total of **78,637**, an increase by **41,787 persons (113.4%)** from the total number of Senior Citizens in the province 20 years ago.

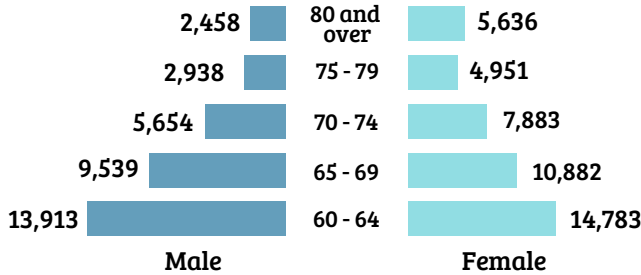


In 2020, nearly **nine out of 100 persons (8.7%)** in the province are Senior Citizens. Among its city/municipalities, the proportion of Senior Citizen is highest in **Pola (10.1%)** and lowest in **Bulalacao (6.1%)**.

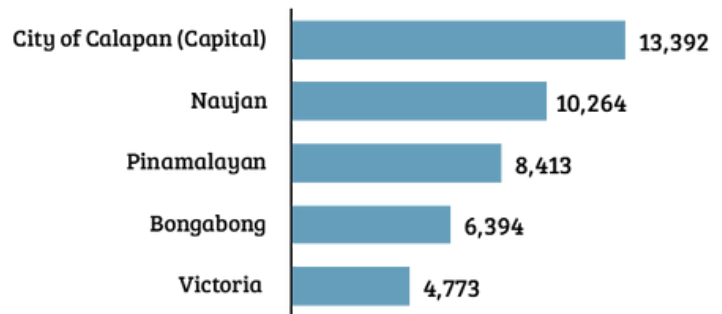
Proportion of Senior Citizens by Municipality: 2020



Age-Sex Population Pyramid of Senior Citizens: 2020

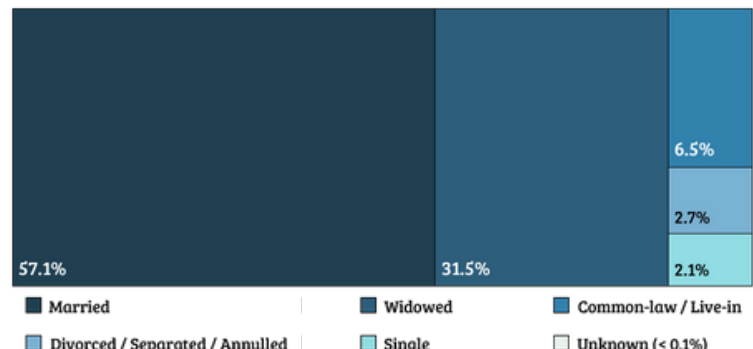


Top Five City/Municipalities with the Highest Total Population of Senior Citizens: 2020



Nearly **three in every five Senior Citizens (57.1%)** in the city were legally married.

82.2% of all Senior Citizens were **Roman Catholic**. Other top religious affiliations by Senior Citizens were **Iglesia ni Cristo (3.8%)** and **Seventh Day Adventist (1.7%)**.
