There are more death occurrences among males than females.

The highest number of deaths occurred in the **70-74 age** group with a total of **121** deaths while the lowest was in the **05-09 age group** with four registered deaths.

by place of usual residence



540 or 56.2% of the total recorded deaths occurred at home while 413 or 43.0% of the total recorded deaths occurred at health facilities and 8 or 0.8% occurred in others.

January has the most number of deaths registered at **97**





a total of **958** deaths were timely registered



three deaths were registered late

There were 23 deaths attended by private physicians, 12 deaths attended by public health officers, two deaths attended by other health officials and 391 deaths attended by hospital authorities, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.

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32 infant deaths recorded

There are **21** recorded infant deaths among males, compared to **11** females.



Top 5 Causes of Deaths

- 1. Other acute ischaemic heart diseases 9.1%
- 2. Hypertensive heart disease -5.9%
- 3. Acute myocardial infarction 4.9%
- 4. Unspecified diabetes mellitus -4.5%
 5. Respiratory tuberculosis, not confirmed bacteriologically or histologically - 3.7%
