

Average deaths per month

The highest number of deaths occurred in the 75-79 age group with a total of **35** individuals died, while the lowest was in the 5-9 age group with a total of three registered death.

deaths occurred at home while 86 or 28.4% of the total deaths occurred at health facilities.

212 or 70% of the total recorded

April has the most number of deaths registered at **31**





a total of **298** deaths were timely registered



a total of **five** death was registered late

There were three deaths attended by private physician, and 83 deaths attended by hospital authorities, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.



Nine infant deaths recorded

There are **five** recorded infant deaths among males, compared to four among females.



- 2. Stroke, not specified as haemorrhage or infarction-6.9%
- 3. Pneumonia, organism unspecified 6.6%
- 4. Respiratory tuberculosis, not confirmed bacteriologically or histologically - 5.6%
- 5. Motor- or nonmotor-vehicle accident, type of vehicle unspecified - 4.3%
