

Average deaths

There are more death occurrences among males than females.

The highest number of deaths occurred in the 65-69 age group with a total of 95 deaths, while the lowest was in the 5-9 age group with a total of two registered deaths.



510 or 70.1% of the total recorded deaths occurred at home while 213 or 29.3% of the total deaths occurred at health facilities.

December has the most number of deaths registered at 76.





a total of **724** deaths were timely registered



a total of **four** deaths was registered late

There were 12 deaths attended by private physicians, five attended by public health officers and 201 deaths attended by hospital authorities, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.



26 infant deaths recorded

There are **14** recorded infant deaths among males, compared to 12 females.



Top 5 Causes of Deaths

- 1. Acute myocardial infarction 13.2%
- 2. Stroke, not specified as haemorrhage or infarction -5.6%
- 3. Pneumonia, organism unspecified 4.5%
- 4. Unspecified diabetes mellitus 3.8%
- 5. Motor- or nonmotor-vehicle accident, type of vehicle unspecified - 3.2%
