The highest number of deaths occurred in the **70-74 age group** with a total of **669** deaths while the lowest was in the **05-09 age group** with **37** registered deaths.

3,607 or 62.7% of the total recorded deaths occurred at home while **2,113 or 36.7%** of the total recorded deaths occurred at health facilities and **36 or 0.6%** occurred in other places.

December has the most number of deaths registered at **557**.

There were **137 deaths attended by** private physician, 205 deaths attended

by public health officials, 28 deaths

attended by other health officials and 1,991 deaths attended by hospital

authorities, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.

Top 5 Causes of Deaths

1. Acute myocardial infarction - 8.8% 2. Pneumonia, organism unspecified -5.2% 3. Respiratory tuberculosis, not confirmed

4. Unspecified diabetes mellitus - 3.3% 5. Intracerebral haemorrhage - 3.1%
