Field Supervision on Cereals Survey at San Jose, Occidental Mindoro



As part of the monthly Cereals Survey of PSA Occidental Mindoro, Statistical Analyst, Niepray R. Mendoza conducted her supervision to some of the sample household of the survey.

The supervision was conducted to ensure the accuracy of data that is being collected by the hired statistical researcher. Cereal Surveys such as Palay and Corn Production Survey (PCPS), the Palay/Corn Stocks Survey (PCSS), aims to generates estimates on palay and corn production, area, and yield. assesses stock levels compared to the same period last year and the previous month.

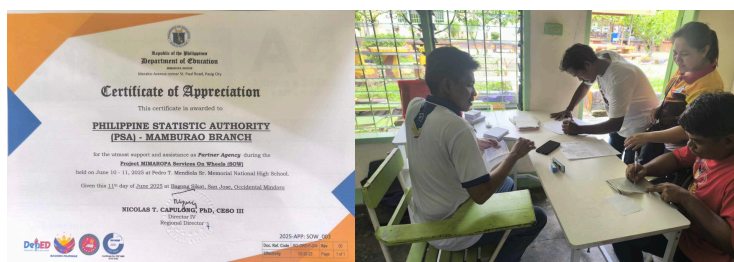
The office offered the Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP) and National ID registration services for those

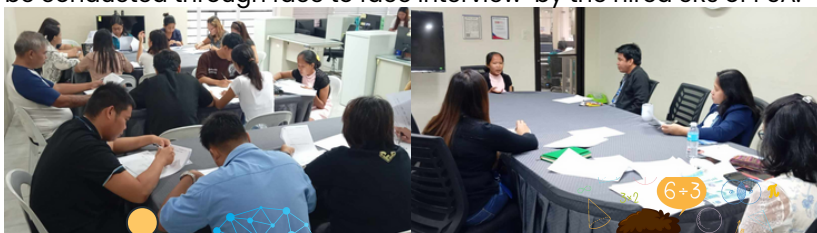


Hiring of July 2025 LFS and 2025 FIES Team Supervisors and Statistical Researchers

As part of the hiring process of PSA Occidental Mindoro, the office conducted a two-day hiring process for the July 2025 Labor Force Survey (LFS) and 2025 Family Income and Expenditures Survey Visit 1 at Provincial Statistical Office of Occidental Mindoro on June 24-25, 2025.

The monthly LFS aims to generate high frequency data on the Philippine labor market to better monitor and assess the country's employment situation and economic conditions. Meanwhile, the FIES aims to gather detailed information on family income and expenditure, including sources of income and spending levels.

The office successfully hired 6 Team Supervisors and 53 Statistical Researchers to conduct survey to all eligible sample household in the province. The data collection will start on July 08 to 31, 2025 and will be conducted through face to face interview by the hired SRs of PSA.
