UPDATES ON THE PHILIPPINE IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM STEP 2 REGISTRATION AND ISSUANCE OF THE PHILID/ EPHILID

As Step 2 Registration resumed on **03 January 2024**, the cumulative output for the year 2024 was **5,023 registrants**. This is equivalent to **39.32 percent** of the total quarterly target. For the month of **January**, PhilSys Registration Team registered a total of **1,020 registrants**, **1,797** for the month of **February** and **2,206** for the month of **March**.

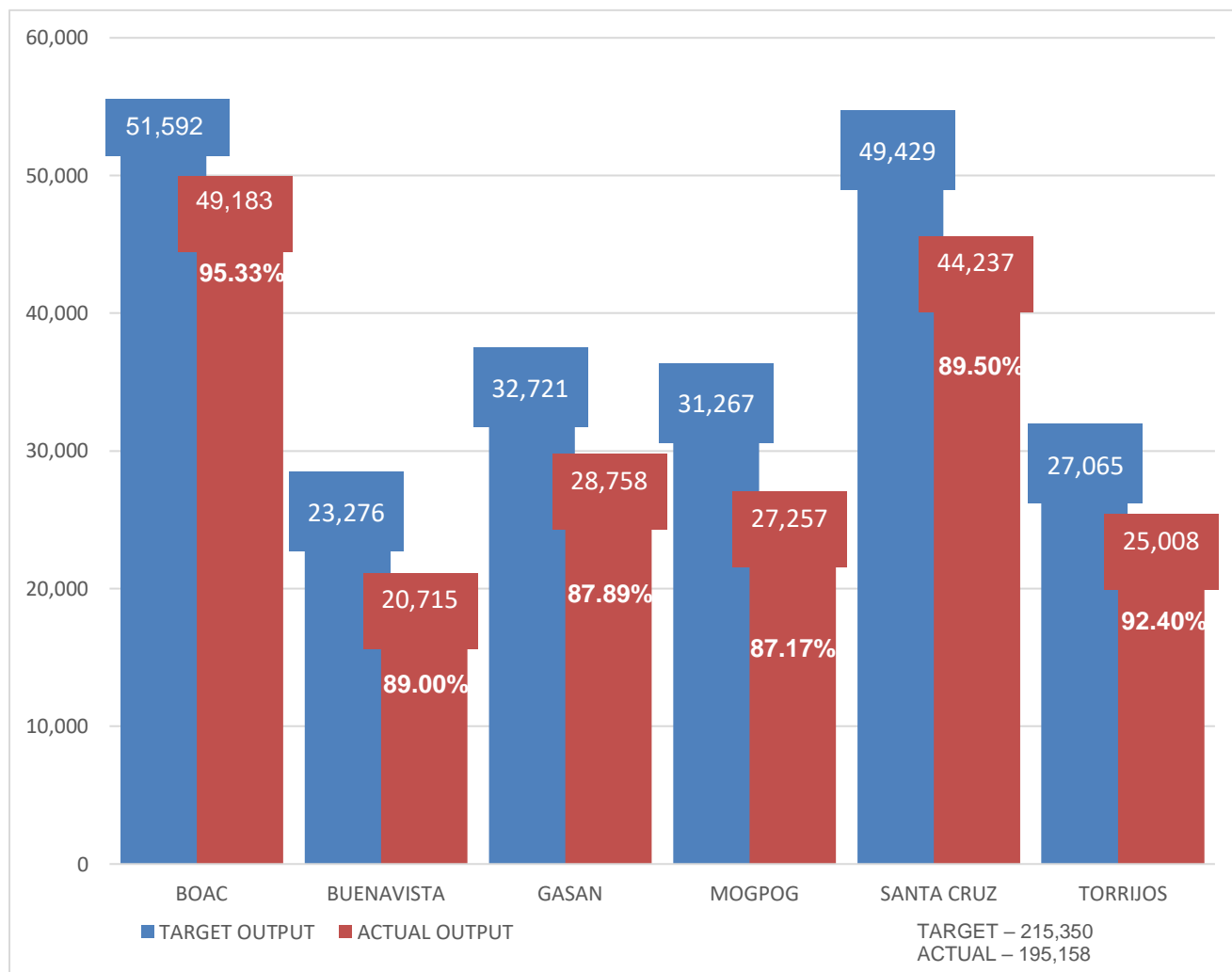

On 28 June 2021, PhilSys started the Step 2 Registration in the province of Marinduque with a target of 215,350 registrants, all of which are five years old and above. By the beginning of 2024, the Marinduque Provincial Statistical Office has already registered a cumulative total of **195,158 Marinduqueños** including children below 5 years old, which is equivalent to **90.62 percent** of the target individuals set in 2021.

The municipality with the highest number of registrants was the Municipality of Boac with **49,183 registrants**, which is equivalent to **95.33 percent** of the population target. On the other hand, the municipality of Mogpog has the lowest number of registered registrants with a total of **27,257 registrants**, equivalent to **87.17 percent** of the population target.

As of **31 March 2024**, the number of completed Step 2 Registrations in the province of Marinduque was **195,158**, which accounts for **90.62 percent** of the target population.

PHILID DELIVERY UPDATES ACCORDING TO PHILPOST

By the end of December 2023, PhilPost has already delivered **70,243 PHILIDs** throughout the province of Marinduque. Among all municipalities, the highest number of issued PhilIDs was recorded in the **Municipality of Boac**, with a total of **23,436 PhilIDs**, while the **Municipality of Buenavista** has the lowest number of issued PhilIDs with the total of **4,506 PhilIDs**.

ISSUANCE OF EPHILID

In January 2024, **1,677 ePhilIDs** were issued, reaching **38.33 percent** of the monthly target and in February 2024, **2,325 ePhilIDs** were issued, meeting **53.14 percent** of the monthly target. Additionally, **1,949 ePhilIDs** were issued in March, which accounted for **48.42 percent** of the monthly target.

As of **31 March 2024**, the total number of issued ePhilIDs in the province of Marinduque has reached **156,454**. Among all municipalities, the highest number of issued ePhilIDs was recorded in the **Municipality of Santa Cruz**, with a total of **40,470 ePhilIDs**, while the **Municipality of Buenavista** has the lowest number of issued ePhilID with the total of **16,980 ePhilIDs**. Meanwhile, there are **82** ePhilIDs that were issued to residents of other provinces.
