2023 Causes of Death in Women in Oriental Mindoro

Explanatory Notes

Data on causes of deaths presented in this press release were obtained from the timely and late registered deaths at the Office of the City/Municipal Civil Registrars all throughout the country and forwarded to the Philippine Statistics Authority -Provincial Statistical Offices. This release shows an information of the registered deaths that occurred from January to December 2023. Deaths of Filipinos that occurred abroad which were reported to the Philippine Foreign Service Posts are presented in a separate report. The figures shown were not adjusted for under registration.

31 March 2025 - CALAPAN CITY, ORIENTAL MINDORO. The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Provincial Statistical Office (PSO) of Oriental Mindoro reports that the three causes of deaths in the province of Oriental Mindoro for the year 2023 among women were Acute myocardial infarction, Pneumonia, organism unspecified, and malignant neoplasm of breast.

Acute myocardial infarction was the leading cause of death with 214 cases accounting for 8.7 percent of the total deaths provincewide. Pneumonia, organism unspecified followed as the second leading cause with 161 deaths representing 6.5 percent of the total. Malignant neoplasm of breast ranked third with 86 recorded cases constituting 3.5 percent of the total deaths.








Figure 1. Top 10 Leading Causes of Death in Women, Oriental Mindoro: 2023
