PSA Oriental Mindoro Replaces PhillD with Damaged and/or Defective Front Facing Photograph

Last 12 May 2023, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Oriental Mindoro Provincial Office formally began accepting requests for replacement of PhillDs with damaged and/or defective front facing photographs. This is to guarantee that PhillD owners can avail the PhilSys-enabled services. As of 10 June 2024, PSA Oriental Mindoro has received 466 requests for replacement PhillDs, of which 154 had already been issued to the requesters.

To file a request for the replacement of PhilID, cardholders may visit the PhilSys PSA-Based Registration Center in Oriental Mindoro located at Nuciti Central Calapan, Brgy.Camilmil, Calapan City. The cardholder must accomplish the request

form for replacement of PhilID and/or letter bearing the PSN and surrender the PhilID Card with damaged and/or defective photo. An acknowledgement receipt form is given to the requester which will be required in claiming the replacement PhilID. The cardholder is advised to wait for the text message from PSA for the release of the new PhilID.

Mobile registration activities are also conducted in different cities/municipalities within the province of Oriental Mindoro where cardholders may also file a request for replacement of PhillDs with damaged and/or defective photos. These cities/municipalities include Puerto Galera, Baco, Naujan, Victoria, Socorro, Pola, Pinamalayan, Gloria, Bansud, Bongabong, Roxas, Mansalay and Bulalacao.
