In partnership with the Local Government Unit of San Andres, Romblon, through Local Civil Registry Office, the Philippine Statistics Authority - Romblon Provincial Statistical Office successfully awarded free PSA-certified Certificates of Live Birth printed in Security Papers (SECPA) to the beneficiaries of the Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP).
