The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)-Romblon Provincial Statistical Office successfully conducted an information campaign on Civil Registration and National ID at San Andres National High School, Brgy. Poblacion, San Andres, Romblon. Held on 13 February 2025, the event aimed to educate and assist students with civil registration and National ID matters and part of the 35<sup>th</sup> Civil Registration Month celebration with a theme "Building a Resilient, Agile, and Future-fit Civil Registration and Vital Statistics System".



Special Science Class students, together with their adviser, attended the information drive conducted by PSA Romblon as part of the 35<sup>th</sup> CRM celebration.

In the first discussion, Chief Statistical Specialist Engr. Johnny F. Solis underscored the importance of vital statistics as it constitutes the collection of data on vital events in a lifetime of a person as well as relevant characteristics of those events to the life of the person concerned. CSS Solis also shared useful information regarding the basic concepts of civil registration and the importance of R.A 9255, R.A. 9048 and R.A 10172.
