The Philippine Statistics Authority-Romblon Provincial Statistical Office culminated the month-long celebration of the 35th Civil Registration Month (CRM) with the theme "*Building a Resilient*, *Agile*, *and Futurefit Civil Registration and Vital Statistics System*" through a closing ceremony held at DC Munting Paraiso Resort, Brgy. The ceremony featured information dissemination and contests to selected students and coaches from Agnipa National High School, Alad National High School, Macario Molina National High School (MMNHS), Romblon National High School (RNHS) and Montfort Academy, Inc.

Registration Officer II Ms. Maria Cristina M. Uy led the discussion by presenting court decrees and legal instruments on civil registration. Then, Chief Statistical Specialist Engr. Johnny F. Solis provided a lecture on Data Appreciation on Selected Vital Statistics wherein he discussed uses/basic sources of vital statistics, as well as birth, marriage, and death statistics. Also, CSS Solis shared to participants the activities conducted during the celebration of the 35th Civil Registration Month.



Following the discussions, Registration Officer I Engr. Mariel V. Fallarcuna served as the Quiz Master for the Civil Registration Quiz. Five (5) pairs from the above-mentioned schools joined the contest. After three grueling rounds, Macario Molina National High School (MMNHS) was announced as champion while Alad National High School and Agnipa National High School landed in 2nd and 3rd place, respectively.
