PSA Marinduque Continues Its efforts in Advancing PhilSys Purok-Based Registration in the Province

21 September 2024 – BOAC, MARINDUQUE. The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Marinduque Provincial Statistical Office (PSO) remains committed to further expanding the reach of the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) by focusing on inclusive strategies that target every "sitio" and "purok" within the province. This initiative is facilitated through the ongoing implementation of *purok*-based registration drives.

This community-focused approach involves setting up registration centers within *puroks*, or small community clusters, allowing individuals to enroll without the need to travel long distances.

By bringing the registration process closer to residents, the agency ensures that even residents in geographically isolated and remote areas can access the PhilSys services. This decentralized approach significantly reduces the time, cost, and effort associated with traveling to central registration offices, thereby making the process more convenient and encouraging higher participation.



The initiative has already covered multiple barangays, allowing more Marinduqueños to secure their National IDs. With 206,032 registrants who have completed the Step 2 Registration and 160,919 ePhilIDs issued as of 21 September 2024, the ongoing registration drives are important part of the agency's goal to enroll 92 million Filipinos in the PhilSys program.
