Participants received specialized instruction on validating various forms of identification, including Civil Registry documents in security paper, National ID, Driver's License, Philippine Passport, National Police Clearance, NBI clearance, PRC ID, PhilHealth ID, and Tax Identification Card. The session provided hands-on exercises, allowing attendees to closely examine security features, detect potential fraudulent documents, and apply standard verification protocols effectively.
