The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Marinduque Provincial Statistical Office recently conducted a specialized workshop titled "Introduction to Time Series and Forecasting and Mastering Data Management: A Guide to Google Sheets and MS Excel." This initiative aimed to enhance the data handling and analytical skills of PSA staff, enabling them to utilize advanced tools for statistical analysis and forecasting.

The afternoon continued with "Mastering Data Management: A Guide to Google Sheets and MS Excel," led by Ms. Maria Baby Jane M. Sualog, Statistical Specialist II, and Ms. Michelle M. Macutong, Registration Officer I. This interactive segment provided hands-on training in data organization, efficient data manipulation, and advanced data analysis techniques within Google Sheets and MS Excel, enhancing the participants' ability to work with large datasets effectively.

Ms. Ginalyn M. Muhi, Registration Officer II, concluded the event with closing remarks, encouraging participants to apply their newly acquired skills in their daily work to elevate data quality and efficiency in statistical reporting.
