In line with the 35th National Statistics Month (NSM) observance, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Provincial Statistical Office of Marinduque hosted a one-day training session on 07 November 2024, aimed at enhancing the skills of Local Civil Registry Office (LCRO) staff across the province. The training, held at the Marinduque Provincial Statistical Office, focused on empowering participants with the tools necessary for data analysis, basic statistics, and data visualization through infographics.
