PSA-Marinduque, in partnership with the Provincial Government of Marinduque and Provincial Planning and Development Office, conducted Training on Data and Statistics with Data Visualization Using Infographics in celebration of the 35th National Statistics Month at Marinduque Provincial Capitol, Bangbangalon, Boac, Marinduque.

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Marinduque Provincial Statistical Office, in partnership with the Provincial Government of Marinduque and Provincial Planning and Development Office, successfully hosted a two-day training program titled "Understanding Data and Basic Statistics with Data Visualization Using Infographics." Held on 29-30 October 2024, at the Marinduque Provincial Capitol, the event brought together a diverse group of participants, including government staffs and representatives from various agencies.
