Further, projects like Philippine Identification System and PhilSys Birth Registration Assistance Project were introduced making them target beneficiaries for legal documentation of identity, civil status, and family relationships to facilitate social, economic, and political inclusion and access to services in health, education, employment, civic/ economic services, and activities.

The office lauds the joint initiative of the volunteers, PSA personnel, teachers, and local government officials of Abra de llog for making the success of this vision a fruition.
