

Senior Citizen is defined as any person / resident citizen of the Philippines whose age is 60 years old and over as defined in Section 3 of the Republic Act 9994, otherwise known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010. Globally, older persons refer to those individuals whose age is at least 60 years.




In 2020, the number of persons 60 years old and over in the MIMAROPA Region registered a total of 272,834, an increase by 142,387 persons (109.2%) from the total number of Senior Citizens in the region 20 years ago. 272,834





In 2020, nearly three in every five Senior Citizens (59.7%) in the region or were legally married.

One in every five Senior Citizens in the region (20.1%) were Indigenous Peoples (IPs). Seven in every nine Senior Citizens (77.8%) are Non-IPs.
