

Senior Citizen is defined as any person / resident citizen of the Philippines whose age is 60 years old and over as defined in Section 3 of the Republic Act 9994, otherwise known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010. Globally, older persons refer to those individuals whose age is at least 60 years.



In 2020, the number of persons 60 years old and over in Marinduque registered a total of 29,361, an increase by 12,134 persons (70.4%) from the total number of Senior Citizens in the province 20 years ago.






