



Inflation Rate = 5.8

In April 2021, Occidental Mindoro's inflation rate decreased to 5.8% from 6.6% recorded in March 2021

> **Purchasing Power** of Peso



= 0.76

This means that a Peso in 2012 is worth 0.76 centavos on April 2021

Technical Notes:

Consumer Price Index (CPI) - is an indicator of the changes in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base

Inflation Rate (IR) - is the rate of change of the CPI expressed in percent.

Purchasing Power of Peso (PPP) - shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in another period. It gives an indication of the real value of the peso in a given period relative to the peso value in the base period. PPP is inversely related to inflation rate. Thus, as inflation increases, PPP declines.
