335 of the total recorded deaths occurred at home while 161 of the total registered deaths took place at the hospital



a total of **484** deaths were timely registered



a total of **14** deaths were registered late



6 out of 10 deaths were not attended by any health care provider



17 infant deaths recorded



There are **9** recorded infant deaths among males, compared to **8** among females.



Top 5 Causes of Deaths

- 1. Essential (primary) hypertension 14.3%
- 2. Respiratory tuberculosis, not confirmed bacteriologically or histologically 8%
- 3. Pneumonia, organism unspecified 5.4%
- 4. Motor- or nonmotor-vehicle accident, type of vehicle unspecified and Acute myocardial 3.0% infarction
- 5. Unspecified diabetes mellitus 2.4%
