

### PURCHASING POWER OF PESO IN MIMAROPA REGION: DECEMBER 2022 TO DECEMBER 2023

The PURCHASING POWER OF PESO shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in the current period. It is computed as the reciprocal of the CPI for the period under review multiplied by 100.



The headline inflation rate in the Philippines posted at 3.9 percent in December 2023. This was lower than the 4.1 percent inflation rate in the previous month. In December 2022, the inflation rate was recorded at 8.1 percent.
