



























In Feb 2021, Occidental Mindoro's inflation rate increased to 7.2% from 6.9% recorded in Jan 2021

Purchasing Power of Peso



This means that a Peso in 2012 is worth 0.76 centavos on March 2021

Technical Notes:

Consumer Price Index (CPI) - is an indicator of the changes in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

Inflation Rate (IR) - is the rate of change of the CPI expressed in percent.

Purchasing Power of Peso (PPP) - shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in another period. It gives an indication of the real value of the peso in a given period relative to the peso value in the base period. PPP is inversely related to inflation rate. Thus, as inflation increases, PPP declines.
