


Senior Citizen is defined as any person / resident citizen of the Philippines whose age is 60 years old and over as defined in Section 3 of the Republic Act 9994, otherwise known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010. Globally, older persons refer to those individuals whose age is at least 60 years.



In 2020, the number of persons 60 years old and over in Occidental Mindoro registered a total of 40,585, an increase by 21,135 persons (108.7%) from the total number of Senior Citizens in the city 20 years ago.



Age-Sex Population Pyramid of Senior Citizens: 2020





Major Ethnic Grouping of Senior Citizens: 2020


