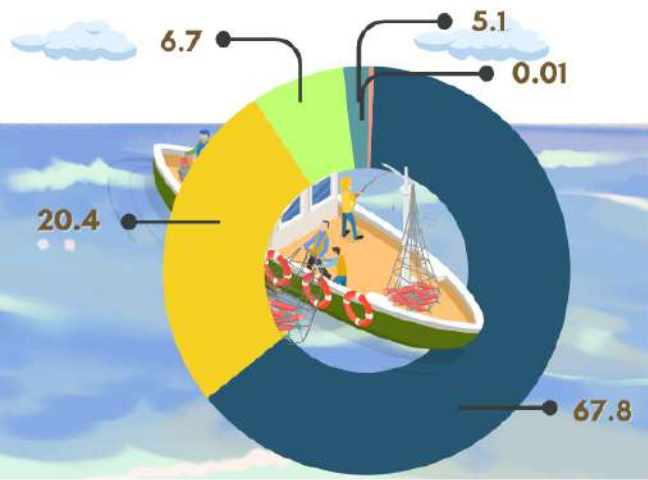

The inland fisheries production in the current quarter was **224.62 metric tons**, reflecting a **68.5%** decline from 712.50 metric tons in the same quarter last year. This production now accounts for just 0.1 percent of the region's total fisheries output.
