
Population Characteristics of in the Province of Palawan


Senior Citizen is defined as any person / resident citizen of the Philippines whose age is 60 years old and over as defined in Section 3 of the Republic Act 9994, otherwise known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010. Globally, older persons refer to those individuals whose age is at least 60 years.



In 2020, the number of persons 60 years old and over in Palawan registered a total of 67,954, an increase by 38,330 persons (129.4%) from the total number of Senior Citizens in the province 20 years ago. 67,954

About seven out of 100 persons (7.2%) in the province are Senior Citizens. The proportion of Senior Citizen is highest in the municipality of Magsaysay (12.6%) and lowest in Kalayaan (2.1%).

Proportion of Senior Citizens by Municipality: 2020




