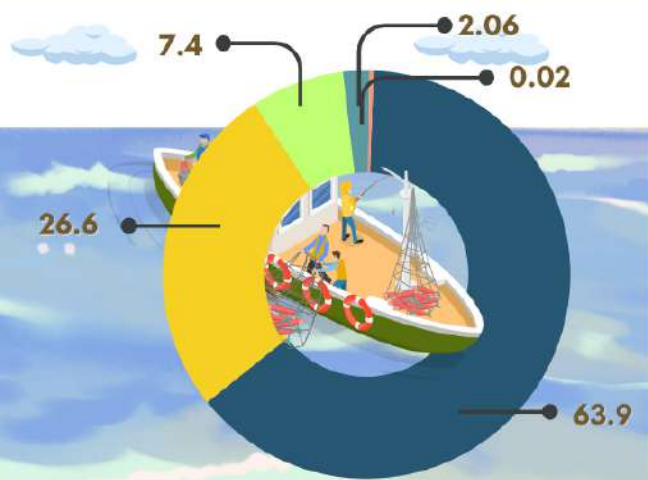

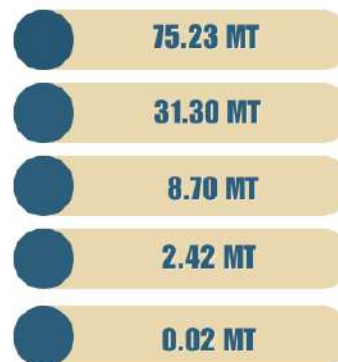
PERCENTAGE SHARE AND VOLUME OF PRODUCTION BY PROVINCE
