There are more death occurrences among males than females.

The highest number of deaths occurred in the **70-74 age group** with a total of **57** individuals died, while the lowest was in the **5-9 age group** with a total of **two** deaths.





279 or 62.4% of the total recorded deaths occurred at home, 166 or 37.1% occurred at health facilities one or 0.2% occurred in others and one or 0.2% is not stated...

**November** has the most number of deaths registered at **52.** 





a total of **440** deaths were timely registered



a total of **seven** deaths were registered late There were 10 deaths attended by private physician, 25 deaths attended by public health officers, and 162 deaths attended by hospital authorities, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.



**18** infant deaths recorded



There are **eight** recorded infant deaths among males, compared to **ten** females.



## **Top 5 Causes of Deaths**

- 1. Essential (primary) hypertension 11. 2%
- 2. Respiratory tuberculosis, not confirmed bacteriologically or histologically- 6.3%
- 3. Acute myocardial infarction 5.8%
- 4. Pneumonia, organism unspecified 5.4%
- 5. Type 2 diabetes mellitus 4.7%
