

The highest number of deaths occurred in the 70-74 and 75-79 age groups with a total of 24 deaths, each, while the lowest was in the 5-9 age group with one registered death.

65 or 30.7% of the total recorded deaths occurred at health facilities while 147 or 69.3 % occurred at home

June has the most number of deaths registered at 27





a total of **208** deaths were timely registered



a total of **four** deaths were registered late

There were 2 deaths attended by private physicians, 69 deaths attended by public health officers and 63 deaths attended by hospital authorities, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.
