The highest number of deaths occurred in the 60-64 age group with a total of **71** individuals died, while the lowest were in the 10-14 and 20-24 age groups with four registered deaths, each.

TOTAL REGISTERED DEATHS



377 or 61.0% of the total recorded deaths occurred at home while 239 or **38.7%** of the total recorded deaths occurred at health facilities, and remaining **two** deaths occurred in other places like street, in public spaces, or during transit.

April has the most number of deaths registered at 66.

There were 16 deaths attended by private physicians, two attended by public health officers and 222 deaths attended by hospital authorities, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.

Top 5 Causes of Deaths

- 1. Acute myocardial infarction 5.7%
- 2. Stroke, not specified as haemorrhage or infarction- 5.0%
- 3. Senility 4.5%
- 4. Type 2 diabetes mellitus 3.6%
- 5. Respiratory tuberculosis, not confirmed bacteriologically or histologically - 3.4%
