The highest number of deaths occurred in the **70-74 age group** with a total of **36** deaths, while the lowest were in the **05-09 and 15-19 age groups** with **two** registered deaths, each.

130 or 54.4% of the total recorded deaths occurred at health facilities while 109 or 45.6% of the total recorded deaths occurred at home.

January has the most number of deaths registered at **26**.





a total of **233** deaths were timely registered



a total of **six** deaths was registered late There were **10 deaths attended by private physicians and 122 deaths attended by hospital authorities**, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.



six infant deaths recorded

There are **three** recorded infant deaths among males, same with females with **three**.

Top 5 Causes of Deaths

- 1. Acute myocardial infarction 9.2%
- 2. Unspecified diabetes mellitus and Other cerebrovascular diseases 5.0%
- 3. Pneumonia, organism unspecified -3.8%
- 4. Chronic kidney disease- 3.3%
- 5. Respiratory tuberculosis, not confirmed bacteriologically or histologically and Type 2 diabetes mellitus - 2.9%
