The highest number of deaths occurred in the **65-69 age groups** with a total of **49** deaths while the lowest were in the **05-09 and 10-14 age groups** with **three** registered deaths, each.



229 or **60.4%** of the total recorded deaths occurred at home while **146** or **38.5%** of the total recorded deaths occurred at health facilities and remaining **four** or **1.1%** deaths occurred in other places like street, in public spaces, or during transit.

January has the most number of deaths registered at **45**.



a total of **379** deaths were timely registered



No death was registered late

There were **29** deaths attended by private physicians, **18** deaths attended by public health officers, one death attended by other health officials and **122** deaths attended by hospital authorities, based on the number of registered deaths by usual residence.



13 infant deaths recorded



There are **seven** recorded infant deaths among males, compared to **six** females.

Top 5 Causes of Deaths



1. Acute myocardial infarction -10.6%
2. Motor- or nonmotor-vehicle accident, type of vehicle unspecified - 5.5%
3. Respiratory tuberculosis, not confirmed bacteriologically or histologically - 5.0%
4. Other cerebrovascular diseases -4.2%
5. Unspecified diabetes mellitus - 4.0%
