

Senior Citizen is defined as any person / resident citizen of the Philippines whose age is 60 years old and over as defined in Section 3 of the Republic Act 9994, otherwise known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010. Globally, older persons refer to those individuals whose age is at least 60 years.



In 2020, the number of persons 60 years old and over in Romblon registered a total of 33,807, an increase by 13,204 persons (64.1%) from the total number of Senior Citizens in the province 20 years ago. 33,807






Proportion of Senior Citizens by Municipality: 2020



Age-Sex Population Pyramid of Senior Citizens: 2020




Top Five Municipalities with the Highest Total Population of Senior Citizens: 2020



Nearly three in every five Senior Citizens (58.1%) in the province were legally married.

68.2% of all Senior Citizens were Roman Catholic. Other top religious affliations by Senior Citizens were Iglesia Filipina Independiente (11.2%) and Church of the Foursquare Gospel (4.6%).
