



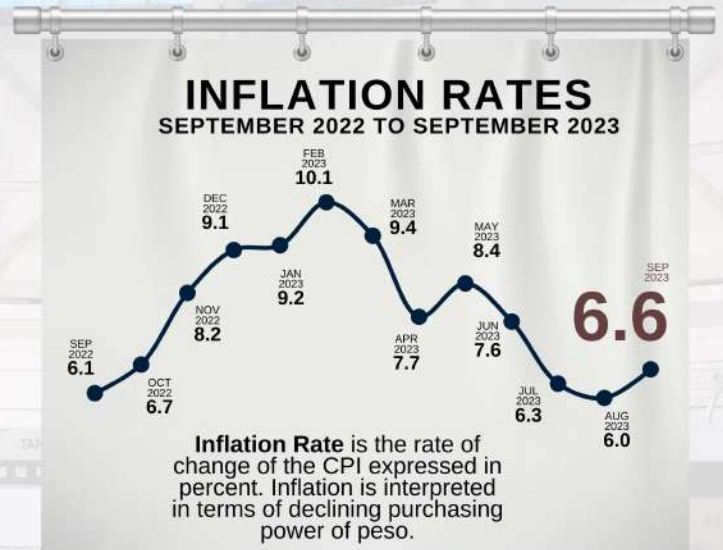

 The Consumer Price Index is an indicator of the changes in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

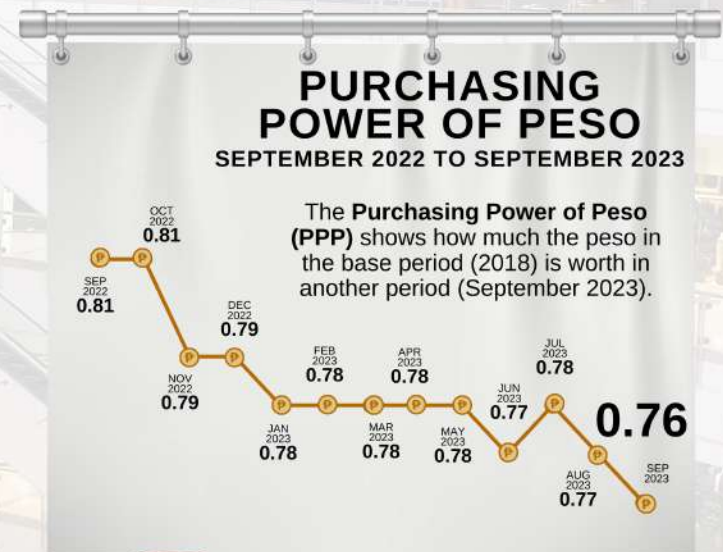
