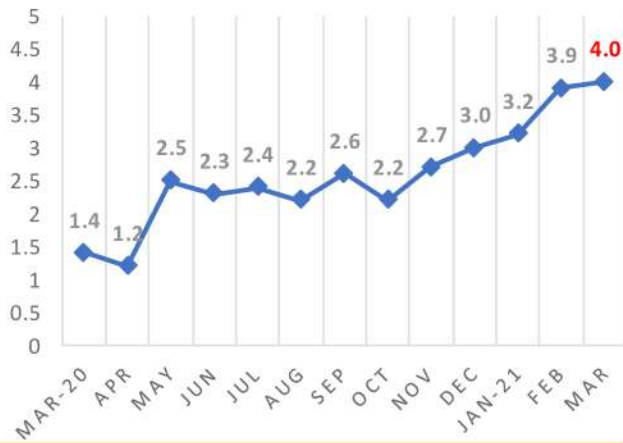
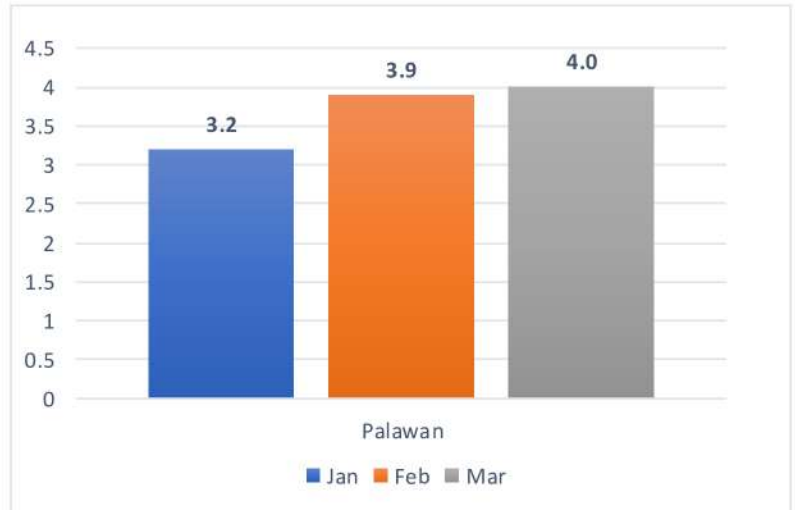


INFLATION RATE IN PALAWAN MARCH 2020 TO MARCH 2021 (IN PERCENT)



The INFLATION RATE is the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change of the CONSUMERS PRICE INDEX expressed in percent. Negative inflation or DEFLATION happens when the price of goods drops.

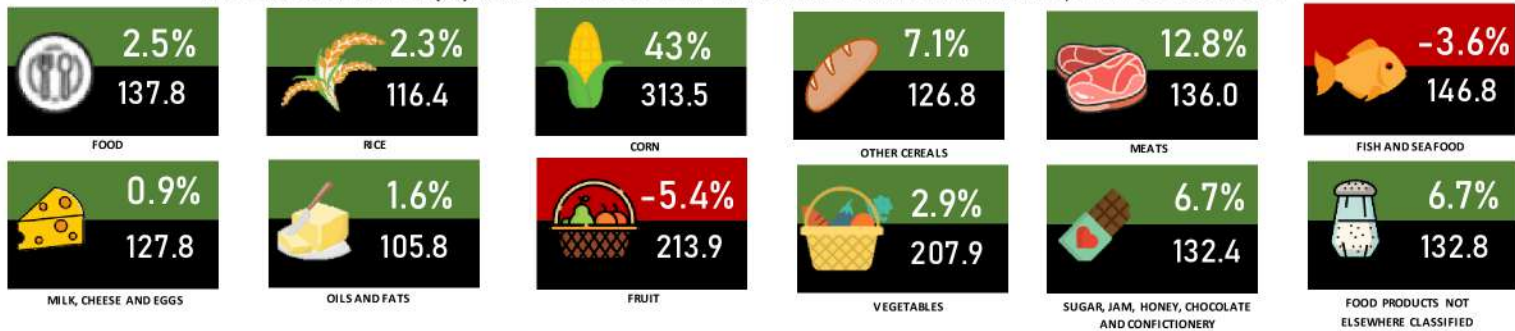
YEAR-TO-DATE INFLATION RATE IN PALAWAN



INFLATION RATE (%) AND CONSUMER PRICE INDEX IN PALAWAN, BY MAJOR COMMODITY GROUP

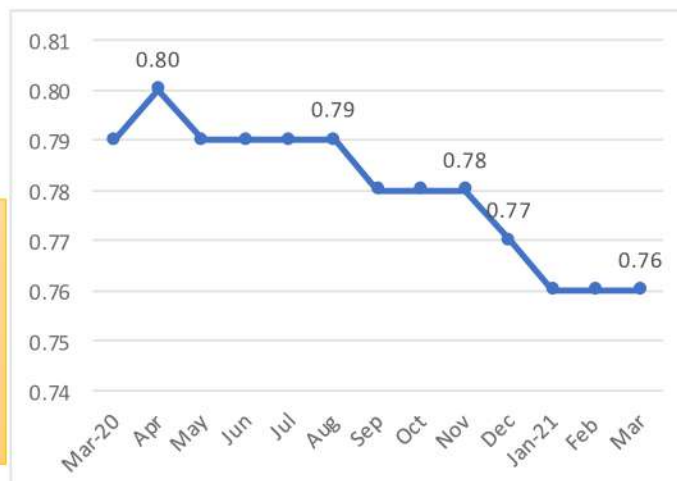


INFLATION RATE (%) AND CONSUMER PRICE INDEX IN PALAWAN, BY FOOD GROUP



PURCHASING POWER OF PESO IN PALAWAN: MARCH 2020 TO MARCH 2021

The PURCHASING POWER OF PESO shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in the current period. It is computed as the reciprocal of the CPI for the period under review multiplied by 100.



The headline inflation rate in Palawan was posted at 4.0 percent in March 2021. This was an increase from the 3.9 percent index from the previous month. In March 2020, the inflation rate was lower, at 1.4 percent.
