PSO Occidental Mindoro Joins BFAR in the Bangus Harvest in Sta. Teresa, Magsaysay

In partnership with the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) - MIMAROPA under the Aquaculture and Mariculture Expansion and Invigoration Project (AMEIP), the PSO Occidental Mindoro joins the celebration of bountiful harvest of Bangus in Sta. Teresa, Magsaysay, Occidental Mindoro.

The bangus harvest started early in the morning to ensure minimal stress on the fish. Despite the minor challenges like scorching hot weather and fish escapes, the local fishers efficiently completed the harvest. A total of 2, 500 pieces or 1,088 kilos of bangus were immediately sorted, weighed, and transported to local market for consumptions.

The successful bangus harvest in Magsaysay stands as a testament to what can be achieved through coordinated effort, government support, and community participation. As preparations begin for the next aquaculture cycle, the municipality looks forward to further strengthen its position as a key contributor to Mindoro's fisheries sector.

Field Supervision on 2024 POPCEN-CBMS SFGP at Apo Reef Natural Park



As part of the on going 2024 POPCEN-CBMS Geotagging of Service Facilities and Government Projects (SFGP), PSA Occidental Mindoro team and regional alternate focal person conducted a field supervision at Apo Reef Natural Park to ensure that all service facilities and government project will be listed and geotagged.

The project aims to to generate baseline data by updating and geotagging service facilities, government projects, and ongoing building constructions. It will collect data on the number number, type, value, construction period, and building permit information.

As a result, Protected Area Superintendent (PASu), Ms. Krystal Villanada provided list of service facilities and government project. PASu also assisted the PSA personnel and show the service facilities of the Apo Reef Natural Park.

Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP) Goes to Iling Island, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro



As part of the PSA Occidental Mindoro's initiative to increase the birth registration particularly in marginalized community in the province, and in partnership with Local Government Unit of San Jose, the team conducted a mobile registration on birth registration assistance project in Iling Island, Barangay Pawican, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro.

The PSA led by Birth Registration Coordinator, Mr. Jericko Rubio joined the Local Civil Registry of San Jose in registering the residents of Iling Island. BRAP provides free and accessible birth registration services to individuals who have never been officially recorded in government registries and seeks to eliminate barriers in registration such as financial constraints, lack of awareness, and difficulty in accessing civil registration offices.

PSA Occidental Mindoro continuous its effort to conduct mobile registrations across the province to ensure that all Mindoreños will be registered to BRAP and have their free birth certificate.

As part of ensuring the accuracy and reliability of data collected on the Farm Price Survey, the Provincial Focal Person, Ms. Creissa Anne R. Untalan conducted a supervision to the newly hired statistical researcher of PSA on April 26, 2025 at Barangay Bayotbot, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro.

Farm Price Survey was done every last Friday of the month, the aim of this is to gather reliable price information at the farm level. Specifically, it seeks to estimate farmgate prices of major agricultural commodities, develop price indices to measure the purchasing power of growers, and provide data for analyzing seasonal trends and variations in agricultural prices. The data collected is crucial for formulating economic programs and policies, as well as for farmers' production planning and decision-making to optimize profits.
