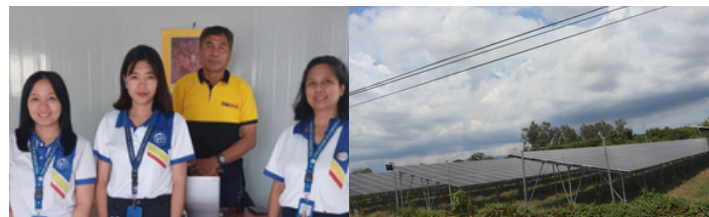


## PROVINCIAL STATISTICAL OFFICE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO

In preparation for the forthcoming estimation of the Regional Accounts of the Philippines (RAP), CSS Maribel L. Bernardo pay a short visit to Occidental Mindoro Consolidated Power Corporation (OMCPD) to gather information about the electric generation capacity of the Solar Farm. As a result, according to the Solar Plant Manager, Engr. Antonio L. Castronuevo there were a total of 3,500 panels installed in San Isidro, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro could generate 6 Mega Wattage.

### Field Visits to LGUs on the Conduct of PSA-LGU Data Sharing, PPA Compilation and PSIC Orientation



As part of the compilation of 2024 Provincial Product Accounts processing of PSA-LGU Data Sharing (PLDS) for Business Registers Project, field visit and validation was conducted to LGU Sablayan and LGU San Jose.

The PLDS-BRP aims to create a complete and more reliable database of businesses operating in the Philippines. This strategy aligns with the modular approach adopted for Statistical Business Register (SBR) design, effectively utilizing administrative data to improve the overall quality of business statistics. To ensure the accuracy and reliability of the data, a field verification was conducted by the PSA Occidental Mindoro focal person.

Furthermore, the orientation on the PSIC and sharing of the joint memorandum agreement provided essential insight for the LGU staff. The visit highlights the importance of continuous collaboration, training and data management to improve the overall efficiency of the business registration and licensing process.



## PSA Occidental Mindoro Conducts the 2024 POPCEN-CBMS Geotagging of Service Facilities and Government Projects (SFGP).

12 March 2025 – Occidental Mindoro. The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Occidental Mindoro conducts the 2024 Census of Population (POPCEN) and Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Geotagging of Service Facilities and Government Projects (SFGP) to all municipalities within the province. This will be used to prepare a compendium of localized fact, figures and maps on different dimension of poverty. Relative to this, geotagging Service Facilities, Government Projects and Building Constructions was conducted on 05 March 2025 to 12 April 2025 by the Map Data Collectors and Team Supervisors.

In line with this, the PSA Occidental Mindoro enjoins the public, government agencies and provincial line agencies to allow the PSA-hired personnel to geotag and collect information about the Service Facilities, Government Projects and on-going building constructions.

## Mobile Acceptance of Requests on Civil Registry Documents at Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro

On March 17, 2025, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) participated in the Cali Serbisyo Caravan for Every Juan with the theme "Serbisyo ng Pamahalaan ang Ilalapit sa Tao, hindi Tao ang Maghahanap nito" held at the Municipal Gymnasium, Barangay Poblacion, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro.

Mobile acceptance of requests on civil registry documents such as birth, marriage, and death certificates, as well as certificates of no marriage (CENOMAR), was served during this activity. A total of 92 requests were collected. Conducting the above-mentioned activities will ensure the essential function of civil registration in providing legal documentation for every Filipino that can help them establish their legal identity, civil status, and ensuing rights.

## PSO Occidental Mindoro Conducts Supervision on Quarterly Municipal Fisheries Survey (QMFS) and Quarterly Commercial Fisheries Survey (QCFS)

In line with the continuous conduct of the Quarterly Municipal Fisheries Survey and Quarterly Commercial Fisheries Survey, the PSO Occidental Mindoro conducted supervision on selected sample landing centers in the province. The supervision is done to ensure the accuracy and reliability of fisheries data collected by the statistical researchers of PSA on municipal and commercial

fisheries survey.

The PSA team pay a courtesy call to the barangay captain before conducting a field supervision on the landing center. During the supervision, the Focal Person visited the landing center where the activities takes place. Interviews were conducted with fishers and statistical researcher to ensure the consistency of data and to identify errors in the survey conducted.

## PSA Occidental Mindoro Continues the National ID Registration Drive

As part of the agency's initiative, the National ID registration team of PSA Occidental Mindoro continuously conduct its registration to the different municipalities in the province. In partnership with the Local Government Units of Occidental Mindoro and Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), the National ID team successfully registered a total of 6, 544 individuals and issued 157 National ID in Paper Form for the month of March 2025.

PSA Occidental Mindoro encourages Mindoreños to register for the National ID System to secure their National ID, which serves as a valid proof of identity for public and private transactions.



## PSA Occidental Mindoro Joins the Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill



On March 13, 2025, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) of LGU Mamburao, under the leadership of Mr. Zyron Wendell D.
