Conduct of Coastal Clean-up Drive at Barangay Balansay, Maburao

In a unified effort to protect the environment in partnership with Barangay Balansay, PSA Occidental Mindoro successfully conducted a coastal clean up in Barangay Balansay, Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro on 10 May 2025.

The activity was part of the social responsibility of the office to ensure that the shoreline in the community remains clean and safe for marine species. PSA personnel and barangay representatives worked together to remove accumulated waste and debris along the shoreline. Field Supervision on Retail Price Survey at San Jose Public Market





As part of the monthly Retail Price Survey of PSA Occidental Mindoro, Chief Statistical Specialist, Maribel L. Bernardo, PhD conducted her supervision to one of the sample outlet in the province.

The supervision was conducted to ensure the accuracy of data that is being collected by the hired statistical researcher. During the supervision it was observed that most of the store owners/respondents were cooperative and provide accurate data. Prices of some commodity like vegetables and rice has significantly dropped due to the higher production of the commodity in the province. However, prices of meat especially the pork was still in its peak compared to other meat products. The higher price of pork was an effect of the African Swine Fever in 2024 that leads to the shortage of supply of pork in all areas in the province.

The collected price in all sample outlets in Occidental Mindoro is used for the generation of the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

The CPI is a measure of the average change over time in the prices paid by local consumers for a basket of consumer goods and services. It is a key indicator of inflation, reflecting how prices of everyday goods and services are changing.

PSA Occidental Mindoro Conducts Third Level Training on Labor Force Survey with Volunteer Works

PSA Occidental Mindoro successfully conducted the training on monthly Labor Force Survey with Rider Questions on Volunteer Work on May 4-7, 2025 at Provincial Statistical Office of Occidental Mindoro.

The survey aims to generate reliable data on volunteerism in the province. Data collected will support the assessment of the economic impact of volunteer work that provide the policymakers and program managers with insights to formulate policies and guidelines that promote civic engament, voluntary participation, and innovative volunteer infrastructure. The rider questions are designed to capture relevant information on volunteer activities within the labor force across the province.

The three-day training was done to equipped the statistical researchers on the proper concepts of the survey. The training helps the hired SRs to conduct the interview in a way that the respondents will provide accurate information and reliable data. With this, PSA encourages sample respondents to actively participates on the ongoing project of the office.

PSA Occidental Mindoro Attends the 2024 FLEMMS Regional Data Dissemination Forum of PSA MIMAROPA



In a momentous ceremony, the Philippine Statistics Authority Regional Statistical Services Office - MIMAROPA disseminates the results of the 2024 Functional Literacy, Education, and Mass Media Survey (FLEMMS) on May 30, 2025 in Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro.

The data dissemination was graced by the Regional Director, Leni R. Rioflorido, Oriental Mindoro Congressman, Hon. Arnan C. Panaligan, experts from the Department of Education, Department of Planning and Development, and attended by the Chief Statistical Specialist of Occidental Mindoro, Maribel L. Bernardo, PhD and Provincial Focal Person, Ms. Juliza S. Destor.

The regional dissemination forum revealed that nine out of ten aged 5 years and over or 89.2 percent are Basic Literate and seven out of ten aged 10-64 years or 68.8 percent are Functional Literate in Occidental Mindoro in 2024. The data will be used by the policymakers to formulate policies, especially in implementing interventions to improve literacy and education in the region. It also helps identify areas where further support is needed, such as addressing disparities in literacy rate or ensuring access to quality education.
